Ordering Object Pronouns



10 common semi-auxiliaries which are followed by an infinitive verb.

Remember this order: subject + conjugated semi-auxiliary + object pronoun + infinitive verb.

<u>Verbs</u>	<u>Translation</u>	<u>Example</u>	<u>Translation</u>
aimer	to like, to love	J'aime les écouter quand je suis triste.	I like to listen to them when I'm sad.
aller	to go	Je vais nous faire une omelette.	I'm going to make an omelette for us.
détester	to hate	Je déteste lui parler d'argent.	I hate talking about money with him.
devoir	to have to, must	Tu dois le porter quand il pleut !	You must wear it when it's raining!
essayer (de)	to try to	Tu essaies de lui téléphoner ?	Are you trying to call her?
pouvoir	to be able to, can	Il peut nous prêter sa voiture pour le week-end !	He can lend us his car for the weekend.
préférer	to prefer	Vous préférez me payer la semaine prochaine ?	Do you prefer to pay me next week?
refuser de	to refuse to	Nous refusons de te laisser sortir ce soir !	We refuse to let you go out tonight!
souhaiter	to wish, to want	Je souhaite vous remercier pour votre coopération.	I want to thank you for your cooperation.
venir (de)	to come, to have just done	Nous venons vous apporter un cadeau.	We are coming to bring you a present.
vouloir	to want	Je voudrais te dire un secret.	I would like to tell you a secret.
